Purchase and sale of Elia Group shares in the context of the liquidity agreement

Within the framework of the liquidity agreement (see press release dated July 29, 2021), Elia Group reports today that Exane BNP Paribas on behalf of Elia Group has purchased 3,900 Elia Group shares during the period between 17 July 2023 and 21 July 2023 on Euronext Brussels. During the same period, Exane BNP Paribas on behalf of Elia Group has sold 3,950 Elia Group shares.
